



Environmental Sustainability Policy

The policy of Newline Logic Limited ('the Company'), trading as Daracore, is to protect and enhance local and global environments by giving environmental considerations equal importance to traditional business issues.

This commitment means that we ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that our activities are carried out in ways that are sustainable and the impacts of which are minimized, in the local communities in which we operate.

We therefore:

- Maintain awareness of all applicable and new environmental legislation and regulations
- Comply with all applicable environmental legislation and regulations
- Assess the environmental impacts of all our working practices, including the tools and materials that we use *
- Assess the whole life environmental performance of all purchases *
- Work with and monitor the performance of suppliers to ensure that they continually improve the sourcing of materials and products and that they provide services that are continually improving in terms of sustainability and ethical means of production
- Ensure that design, development and construction is undertaken in a manner compatible with sustainable development best practice, adjusting the company's planning accordingly
- Maintain the cleanliness and appearance of premises to the highest practicable standards
- Comply with all Duty of care requirements relating to controlled and hazardous waste
- Aim to minimise:
 - a. Energy use and its associated CO₂ emissions
 - b. The use of water
 - c. The generation of waste through continual process improvements
 - d. Raw material consumption *
 - e. Polluting emissions to air, land and water
 - f. The use of polluting forms of transport
- Aim to maximise:
 - a. The use of renewable energy sources where possible
 - b. The re-use of materials and products i.e. recycling, particularly of those materials and products that are scarce or non-renewable
 - c. The use of recycled materials and products *
 - d. The use of material from renewable sources *
 - e. The use of local products and local workforce

* In relation to the action points identified above, we have developed a Chain of Custody policy specific to the use of timber and timber products, as these, though purchased and used fairly infrequently, comprise the most significant raw materials aspect of our construction and installation processes, in the context of the potential for natural resource renewability.
