Commitment

- We carry out business fairly, honestly, and openly and will not tolerate any form of tax evasion or its facilitation.
- We will not buy goods or use services from suppliers who we know, or suspect, are not properly declaring their income and any relevant tax.
- We will not provide our services to companies or individuals whom we suspect our services to be abused for the purposes of fraudulent tax evasion.

Approach

- Business partners and others who represent us, will be given access to our policy and asked to adhere to our principals.
- Employees must read and observe this policy, act with integrity, and comply with applicable laws.
- Our employees will not engage in transactions where tax evasion is present or suspected.
- Employees found to be in breach of our policy will face disciplinary action and if applicable, dismissal.
- We complete due diligence checks on new clients and suppliers.

Review

This policy is reviewed annually and as necessary to reflect changes in circumstance and legislation.

This policy supports procedures documented in our Integrated Management System, compliant with the requirements of ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and ISO 45001.
